



Transition for NCL President

NCL is proud to announce that Doug Linkhart has been selected as president of the National Civic League. Linkhart replaces current president Gloria Rubio-Cortes, who is retiring at the end of 2015 after more than 17 years with the National Civic League, the last eight of which she served as president.

Rubio-Cortes is the first woman and the first person of color to lead the National Civic League in its 120-year history. Under her leadership, the organization increased its resources and programs promoting social justice, racial healing, youth civic leadership, healthy communities and grade-level reading. She re-energized the flagship program, the 67-year-old All-America City Awards, by spotlighting the


All-America City Updates
