### BACKGROUND

A growing number of initiatives from across the ideological spectrum have emerged in recent years to fight threats of illiberalism, promote patriotism, and protect, reform, strengthen, and champion American democracy. For the most part, this ecosystem of healthy democracy networks, practitioners, and funders is quite diffuse. Those working in the space often lack a shared vision for the future, a collective understanding of resource availability and distribution, and a common definition of what efforts fall within the bounds of "healthy democracy" work.
